



Process for IASR ethics applications

- ◁ All IASR staff and postgraduate research (PGR) student projects must receive ethical approval via the IASR Research Institute Ethics Panel
- ◁ **Advance notification of ethics application (F1 form) is now required.** This should ensure applications are dealt with promptly. Applications should be submitted **no later than three weeks** after notification

- ◁ Expedited approval is granted only in **exceptional circumstances**, i.e. where it has not been possible to submit an application any earlier and work is due to start imminently

- ◁ Once a [F2: Full Ethics Application](#) is received, the IASR Research Ethics Coordinator allocates two members of staff to independentlystaived,
